Computers use software and hardware. Hardware means the machines and devices that we use: a computer, a printer. Software means programs that we write to use the machines: a spreadsheet like Excel, or a browser like Internet Explorer.

The most important part of hardware is the computer. This could be a desktop computer: one that is large and is not easy to move from place to place. Many people now use a laptop: a computer that is smaller and easy to carry. The most important part of a computer is CPU (central processing unit). This is the 'brain' of the machine. You connect other hardware to your computer: a printer, a keyboard, a screen. These are called peripherals. A peripheral might be an input device: you use it to put information onto your computer, like a mouse or a scanner. Other peripherals are output devices: they show information that comes out of your computer, like a screen or a printer.

The most important type of software is the operating system (OS). This is a program that controls the computer itself, like Windows 7 or Mac OS X. Without an OS, you cannot run most other software on your machine. If you make a mistake when you write software, a program will not run correctly. This is because it contains a bug. In serious situations, this makes the computer crash: it stops working and you cannot use it. You then need to **reboot** your machine (start it again).
