- Positive work culture: Better communication and cooperation.

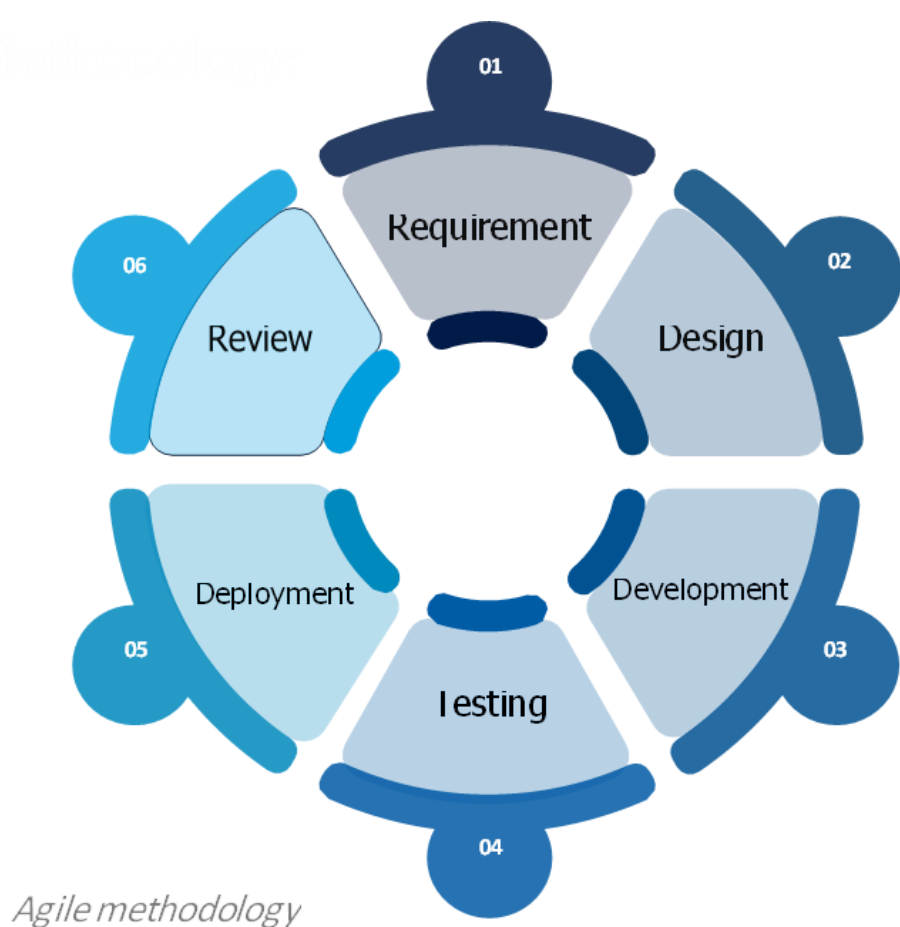
## System Features

- Report generation (RG) - Effective reporting.

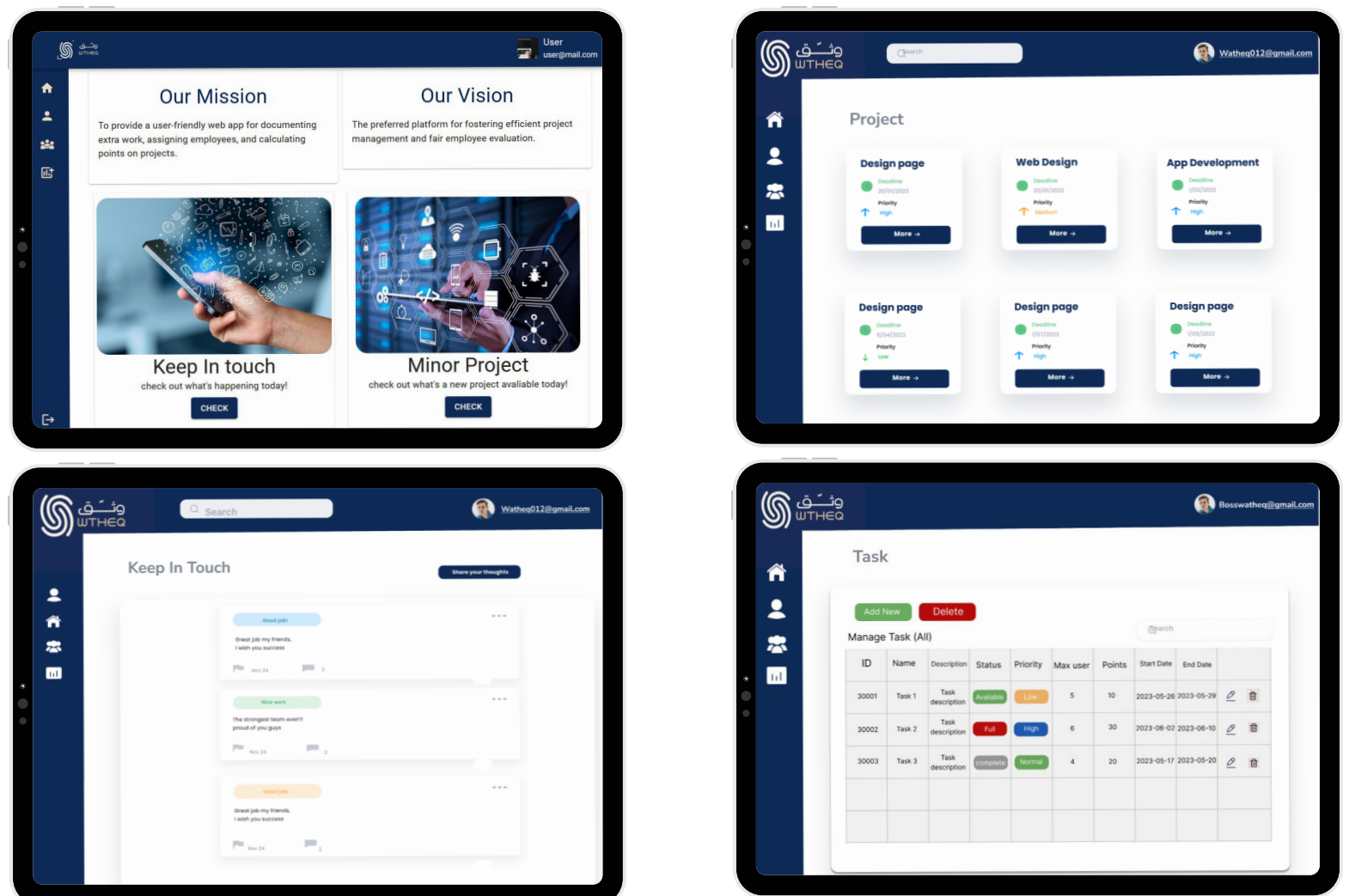
